I agree to a verification by CL&amp;P representative of both the sales transaction and product installation and also allow CL&amp;P access to pre and post-monitor the installation. Falsifying any of the above information will void this rebate application and any future rebate applications. I agree that to qualify for 100% of the rebate or account credit, I must receive all electricity needed by the facility where lighting equipment is installed via CL&amp;P's distribution equipment as a "full-distribution-service" customer. Electricity generated during an interruption of CL&amp;P's distribution service is exempt from this requirement. If I become a non-full-distribution-service customer, or produce electricity from self-generation equipment when there is no interruption in CL&amp;P's distribution service, within three years of receiving the rebate credit, I must repay CL&amp;P a prorated portion of the amount received.</p>

## REBATE REQUIREMENTS

**APPLICATION OFFER:** This rebate program covers products purchased and installed on or after January 1, 2001. Details of this program and rebate levels are subject to change without prior notice. Contact your local Customer Support office for the latest program details. Applications must be submitted by March 31, 2002. Availability of funding is not guaranteed.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Rebates are available to commercial and industrial electric service customers of CL&P for existing facilities. New construction is **NOT** eligible. Customers must have a peak demand of 349 kW or less. Residential customers may apply for a rebate for common areas of multi-family housing.

**PAYMENT:** Rebates will be paid by check or credit to the electric account. We reserve the right to apply rebates to unpaid or overdue accounts. Please allow 60 days for the check or account credit, but processing may take longer if information is missing on the form.

**REBATE AMOUNT:** In no case will CL&P pay more than 100% of the purchase price shown on the invoice. The maximum rebate amount allowed is \$10,000 per customer account per calendar year. (Primary & secondary schools, and Municipal facilities are eligible for up to \$25,000 per year.)

**PRE-APPROVAL and VERIFICATION:** Rebate exceeding \$1,000 must be pre and post inspected. Additionally, CL&P reserves the right to inspect any installation prior to issuing rebates. For major renovations and inspections, contact your local Customer Support office.

**REBATE LEVELS:** Rebate levels will be "**LOCKED IN**" for 90 days after pre-approval has been granted by a Customer Support Account Executive. If the rebate application is submitted after the 90 days has expired, and the customer was not granted an extension, then the current rebate levels will be used.

**TAX LIABILITY:** CL&P will not be responsible for any tax liability imposed on the customer as a result of the rebate payments. All customers must supply their federal tax identification number or social security number in order to receive a rebate. We will issue a 1099 to all unincorporated customers receiving rebates in excess of \$600.00.

**ENDORSEMENT:** CL&P does not endorse any particular manufacturer, product, or system design in promoting the lighting rebate program. The products shown on the eligible product list of electronic ballasts meet recommended company harmonic distortion and ballast factor criteria.

## PRODUCT REQUIREMENTS

**U.L. LISTING:** Items eligible for a rebate must be U.L. listed. Reflectors must be U.L. classified.

**WATTAGE REDUCTION:** There must be at least a 10% system wattage reduction between the old and new wattage for each product to qualify.

**INDOOR APPLICATIONS ONLY:** All rebate products must be installed in indoor applications only.

**T-8 FIXTURES:** Conversions to T-8 systems can either be total fixture replacement or simply a lamp and ballast replacement. 4 foot, 3 and 2 foot lamps qualify. 8 foot T-8 ballast qualify as a slimline ballast. See Electronic Ballasts Section.

**ELECTRONIC BALLASTS:** Rebates for electronic ballasts must be indicated on the eligible product list. Please see the Endorsement statement under Rebate Requirements. All ballast part #'s must be clearly indicated on the attached invoice. T-12 high output electronic ballasts are not eligible for rebate.

**SPECULAR REFLECTORS:** It is recommended that a sample area of reflectors be installed to ensure satisfaction with light output and distribution. Lamps must be re-centered after original lamps are removed, the reflector must cover the full face of the fixture and the ballasts must be upgraded to electronic. The reflector must have the appropriate U.L. Classification Marking. These devices have been evaluated by U.L. to determine that when used in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions, they do not adversely affect the operation of the complete fixture. Installation of the retrofit devices must be approved by the local Building Official to ensure compliance with the State Building Code. All reflector projects must be inspected.

**PARABOLIC FIXTURES:** New parabolic fixtures must be installed. No parabolic retrofit kits on existing fixtures are allowed. Only large cell fixtures (12, 18, 24, 27 cells per fixture) qualify.

**OCCUPANCY SENSORS:** All occupancy sensors must be hard-wired. Each sensor must control a minimum of **100 watts** to qualify.

**Note: Disposal of Ballasts/Lamps**

Dispose of all discarded ballasts/lamps according to local, state and federal guidelines.
